

ACTIVE EAST & PARTNERSHIPS

Active East operates in the East End of Glasgow and uses effective partnership working as a means of creating a lasting legacy from the 2014 Commonwealth Games.

Working with an ever growing number of youth and sport organisations Active East now works within a partner network of 42 different organisations.

The partnerships between these organisations have been able to create hundreds of sessions across the East End allowing young people to take part in physical activity, youth clubs, arts and crafts, music clubs, drama and many more in a safe and comfortable environment. This gives young people time to meet new people, try new things, experience new opportunities and get out of their comfort zone.

The Active Champion programme works in partnership with other organisations to give young people the opportunity to volunteer in their local area - helping to deliver a variety of different sessions. Opening the door to new training and experiences. The Active Champions are young volunteers who give up their time each week to assist and lead in different sessions all over the East End. In 2017 Active Champions volunteered over 11,000 hours - this would not have been possible without partnership working between organisations to give young people the best experience possible.

Partnership is the key to so many success stories within the Active East programme and allows an extended reach and increased impact when working with young people.
